WHEREAS, the Legislative Affairs Committee has identified and presented key issues to the Webb County Commissioners Court for consideration in the county's legislative agenda.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of Webb County, that:

 - B. Local Government
 - 1. County Permanent School Lands
 - 2. Controlled Substance Screening for County Elected Officials
 - 3. Hours of Work of County Employees
 - 4. Limited Ordinance-making Authority for Counties
 - 5. Webb County Road System Authority
 - C. Transportation
 - 1. End Diversions of State Highway Funds
 - 2. Regulation of Automobile Salvage and Wrecking Yards
 - 3. Infrastructure Funding for Eagle-Ford Shale Region
