**RESOLUTION AND ORDER
WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**

A RESOLUTION OF THE WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT APPROVING TITLE 23 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 144 AUTHORIZING FEDERAL FUNDS TO ASSIST THE STATES IN THE REPLACEMENT OR REHABILITATION OF DEFICIENT BRIDGES LOCATED ON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, ROADS AND STREETS, INCLUDING THOSE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

WHEREAS, the federal off-system bridge program is administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (the State) to replace or rehabilitate structurally deficient and functionally obsolete (collectively referred to as deficient) bridges located on public roads and streets off the designated state highway system; and

WHEREAS, Webb County hereinafter referred to as the Local Government owns a bridge located at Becerra Creek, on Lincoln Road, National Bridge Inventory (NBI) Structure Number 222400AA0112003, Local Designation Number BR; and

WHEREAS, a project to remedy the bridge is included in the currently approved program of projects as authorized by Texas Transportation Commission Minute Order Number 113948 dated May 2014 Control-Section-Job (CSJ) Number 0922-33-113; and


WHEREAS, the usual fund participation ratio for projects on such program is 80 percent federal, 10 percent state and 10 percent Local Government; and


WHEREAS, the estimated local match fund participation requirement on the approved federal off-system bridge project is \$22,103.00 (dollars), hereinafter referred to as the "Amount of Advance Funds to be paid by the Local Government"






