Dear Ms. Heisler,

Greetings. I would like to introduce myself. I am the current County Commissioner for Precinct Two in Webb County, Texas. My precinct includes the townships of Bruni and Oilton, Texas on the eastern-most part of Webb County. Throughout my tenure, I have worked hard to identify the needs of my constituents throughout Precinct Two. Recently, we have identified a need for lighting in the communities of Bruni and Oilton, Texas.

After consultation with our engineering department and AEP representatives, Mr. Paulino Lucio, III and Mr. Lino Villarreal, we have identified the areas where we would like to install some much-needed street lighting. We have limited the lights to the main highways in both communities and have further identified existing power poles to keep the cost of installation to a minimum. Some locations had Mercury Vapor street lights at one point, but it is our understanding that they are now discontinued and will be replaced. There will be eight (8) lights in each community, in two different light sizes. They are the 150 watt and the 250 watt High Pressure Sodium street lights. Below is a list of the locations where we would like the lights to be installed.

In BRUNI, TEXAS – FM Road 2050 at the intersections with 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 11th streets and two in front of the high school.

In OILTON, TEXAS – SH 359 at the entrance in the west side of Oilton and at the intersections with Foster, DeSpain, Torrecillas, Welhousen, Hall, Jones and Ornelas Streets.

Our request for these lights, and to incur the monthly cost associated with them, was presented for approval at the Webb County Commissioners Court meeting of February 24, 2014. A copy of the minutes evidencing their approval is attached for your reference.

I look forward to working with you as we explore the need for further lighting in that area. I want to extend special thanks to Mr. Paulino Lucio, III and Mr. Lino Villarreal, AEP-Laredo District, Webb County Constable Adrian Cortez and County Engineer Luis Perez Garcia for their assistance in identifying the locations which these street lights would most benefit the communities.
