The Court takes Judicial Notice that the Defendant, Juan Ramirez, Jr. was placed on the Pre Trial Diversion (*hereinafter referred to as PTD*) program on the above cause, on or about October 29, 2014.

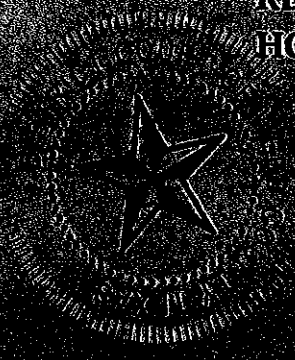
On April 28, 2015, the Webb County Adult Probation Department reported to the Court that Defendant has successfully completed all the requirements of PTD and recommends early termination from the program.

Having considered the recommendation of the Probation Department, the testimony of the Defendant and all other relevant factors, the Court FINDS that good cause exists to allow Defendant to terminate early from the PTD program.

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that said above entitled and numbered cause be the same is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice.


