RESOLUTION AND ORDER

AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR ELECTION DAY PRESIDING JUDGES AND CLERKS; APPOINTING OF ELECTION DAY PRESIDING JUDGES; AND ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CLERKS FOR EACH POLLING SITE FOR THE NOVEMBER 03, 2015 SPECIAL CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ELECTION PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 32.091(a), 32.005 & 32.033, TEXAS ELECTION CODE

WHEREAS the provisions of Section 32.091 (a), Texas Election Code, state that a political subdivision's governing body has the authority to set election workers' compensation at a rate at or above the federal minimum wage; and

WHEREAS the members of the Webb County Commissioners Court believe that the voters of the County of Webb will be better served by presiding judges and clerks who are well-trained, experienced professionals, and thus a fair and reasonable wage is important and should be provided to each presiding judge and clerk; and

WHEREAS the Webb County Commissioners Court as the governing body for the November 03, 2015 Special Constitutional Amendment Election also has the authority and seeks to establish the maximum number of election day clerks to serve at each polling place for said election pursuant to Section 32.033, Texas Election Code;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of Webb County, Texas, that pursuant to Section 32.091 (a), Texas Election Code, salaries for presiding judges and clerks for the **November 03, 2015 Special Constitutional Amendment Election** are established and approved as follows:

Presiding Judges: \$ 10.50 / Hr.

Clerks: \$ 9.25 / Hr.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Webb County, Texas, pursuant to Sections 32.005 and 32.033, that the following are appointed to serve as election day presiding judges in their respective or in the consolidated polling place with the maximum number of clerks to assist in the **November 03, 2015 Special Constitutional Amendment Election** as follows:
