## **AMENDMENT**

The Webb County Head Start Program has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Laredo Independent School District, a Texas political subdivision (hereinafter referred to as "LISD"), in the school campus/site located at Heights Elementary School to serve three (3) full day PreK4 classrooms.

Through this MOU, it confirms that the Laredo Independent School District has agreed that Webb County Head Start Program will provide services to the integrated Head Start classrooms located specifically at Heights Elementary School campus at three (3) classrooms with a 19 to 1 student/teacher ratio for PreK4.

The Webb County Head Start located at Heights Elementary school campus is requesting to amend the existing MOU to provide services on a 17 to 1 student/teacher ratio for one (1) PreK3 classroom and a 19 to 1 student/teacher ratio for two (2) PreK4 classrooms.

The amendment to the MOU should become effective on the date of Laredo ISD Board Approval and will remain in effect through August 31, 2017.
