Pre-Surveys

Prior to conducting any wave enforcement activity, agencies must conduct preobservational surveys to establish safety belt usage rates.

The cities of Arlington, Austin, Corpus Christi, Dallas, El Paso, Fort Worth, Garland, Houston, Lubbock, and San Antonio are scheduled to have their surveys conducted by the Texas Transportation Institute (TTI).

Pre-Media Campaign

Conduct local media events immediately before the enforcement effort to maximize the visibility of enforcement to the public. These media events tell the public when, where, how and why the safety belt laws are being enforced.
