**Amendment Number FIFTEEN**

This is Amendment Number FIFTEEN to the State Financial Assistance Contract for the 2016 – 2017 Biennium between the State of Texas, represented by and through the Texas Juvenile Justice Department, hereinafter called "the Department", and the juvenile board of WEBB County hereinafter called the "Grantee". In consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Department and the Grantee, for the consideration hereinafter detailed, make the following amendment.

**Article I.  
PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF AMENDMENT**

The purpose of Amendment Number FIFTEEN is to delineate the duties of the Department and the Grantee regarding the distribution, receipt and expenditure of grant funding to provide assistance to the Grantee for the Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) Discretionary grant. All provisions in the 2016 - 2017 Biennium State Financial Assistance Contract and any fully executed amendments thereto that do not conflict with the provisions of Amendment Number FIFTEEN remain in full force and effect.

**Article II.

INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS AND DOCUMENT INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE**

Article II, Section 2.1, Subsection 2.1.1 is amended by adding Paragraph 2.1.1.16 to read as follows:

Amendments to Article IV  
OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT  
JUVENILE JUSTICE ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION (JJAEP) SUPPLEMENTAL: GRANT W**

Article IV, Section 4.3 is amended by adding Subsection 4.3.2.3 to read:

**4.3.2.3 Juvenile Justice Alternative Education (JJAEP) Supplemental: Grant W.** To the extent funds are available, the Department shall allocate a one-time distribution of funds in an amount not to exceed \$ 20172 payable to the Grantee for the approved purposes:

**Conversion to IOWA Assessments online to meet required state standards** as outlined in the Grantee's approval notification. These funds are distributed as a supplement to funding which may have been previously allocated by the Department under this grant.


