North Texas TAG

The Dallas County District Attorneys Office submitted an application for grant funding for a BPU attorney to be housed at the North Texas TAG beginning in FY 2018, and that request was included in the BPU's recommendations to the Governor's Office as part of our Legislative Appropriation Request (LAR) developed last year in advance of the session. Accordingly, Dallas County submitted an application for funding in the amount of \$137,984.00, and that amount has been awarded effective September 1, 2017. However, after the application was submitted Dallas County requested an increase in funding so they could fill the position with a very experienced prosecutor with a long record of involvement in organized crime and criminal gang enterprises. The total grant amount now sought is \$183,047.00, or a difference of approximately \$45,000. Because Dallas County is not yet a member of the BPU, it was not able to make this request at a regional caucus.
