

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, a significant portion of the County's ad valorem taxes are delinquent to the County's detriment; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Texas pursuant to the Texas Property Tax Code §§6.30 and §§33.07, provides Counties

with the authority to impose a 15% collection fee and/or charge on delinquent ad valorem taxes of the current 2017 tax year, when it has entered into a tax collection contract with an attorney; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has engaged a private law firm to collect its delinquent ad valorem taxes, and the contract provides for a 15% collection fee and/or charge.

**IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WEBB:**

1. That the County does hereby exercise its right to impose an additional 15% collection fee and/or charge on all delinquent taxes, penalties and interest due, pursuant to the terms of the Tax Code, so long as the County retains a delinquent tax attorney, and
2. That the County's Tax Collector is hereby directed to send out all required notices to delinquent taxpayers of the herein imposed additional 15% collection fee and/or charge on delinquent taxes, penalty and interest, as required by the Tax Code.
