Re: Letter of Intent to apply for Head Start and Early Head Start Refunding Grants

Dear Judge Tijerina:

In accordance with the Webb County Single Point of Contact (SPOC) Policy and Procedures – revised 3/29/17, please accept this "Letter of Intent to Apply" for grant funds under the Department of Health and Human Services. The Head Start Policy Council and the Webb County Head Start/Early Head Start Program requests authorization to apply for a grant of \$10,068,938 (Federal) and \$2,517,235 (Non Federal In-Kind) for a total amount of \$12,586,173 from September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019 for the continuation of Head Start and Early Head Start comprehensive services (Education, Health, Mental Health, Disability, Nutrition, Parent Involvement, and Family Engagement). A. Project Title: Head Start (HS) and Early Head Start (EHS)

Project Description: The HS and EHS program promotes school readiness of children ages birth to five

from low-income families by supporting their development through a

comprehensive approach to service delivery which includes early childhood education, health, mental health, disability, nutrition, and parent engagement services. The program's services and resources are designed to foster stable family relationships, enhance children's physical and emotional well-being, and

establish an environment to develop strong cognitive skills. The transition from preschool to elementary school imposes diverse developmental challenges

that include requiring the children to engage successfully with their peers outside the family network, adjust to the space of a classroom, and meet the expectations

the school setting provides.

Project Analysis:

- 1) What County needs, services or problems will be addressed by this project? Early childhood education, health, mental health, disability, nutrition, and social service needs. Specifically:
 - Early learning: Children's readiness for school and beyond is fostered through individualized learning experiences. Through relationships with adults, play, and planned and spontaneous instruction, children grow in many aspects of development. Children progress in social skills and emotional well-being, along with language and literacy learning, and concept development
 - Health: Each child's perceptual, motor, and physical development is supported to permit them to fully explore and function in their environment. All children receive health and development screenings, nutritious meals, oral health and mental health support. Programs connect families with medical, dental, and mental health services to ensure that children are receiving the services they need.
 - Family well-being: Parents and families are supported in achieving their own goals, such as housing stability, continued education, and financial security. Programs support and strengthen parent-child relationships and engage families around children's learning and development.
