<u>CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:</u> Responsible for all types of Head Start transportation services (Bus Trips, Delivery of Meals, Field Trips, and Mail Delivery) and upkeep of yards.

## QUALIFICATION STANDARDS:

- Preferred CDL class B license, with passenger assistance endorsement, or willing to acquire.
- Must have a minimum of a High School Diploma or GED
- Must be able to speak, read and write English
- Must maintain all local, state and Federal qualifications for position annually

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES:**

- Maintain assigned vehicles in proper running condition
- Transport meals/dishes/mail
- Keep daily records (mileage, gas consumption, etc.)
- Maintain assigned yards
- Successfully complete CPR and First Aid training and maintain certification
- Perform handyman duties as well as other related duties as requested
- Must be able to work with department personnel
- Must be able to follow standard program procedures

## **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be able to sit or stand for prolonged periods of time
- Must be able to lift approximately 50 79lbs. 4-5 times/day
- Must be able to lift, bend, stoop 85%/ 8 hrs.
- Must be able to do 75%/ 8 hrs of walking

## OTHER REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION:

- Drug and Alcohol Policy applies to this job. Pre-employment drug/alcohol testing and criminal background checks are required.
