RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT
For Survey and Site Assessment
Webb County (LRT-LRN-05_Penitas_27.68303,-9960131)

The undersigned (hereinafter referred to as the "Owner") agrees to grant the United States Government, its employees, agents, contractors, and duly authorized representatives (hereinafter referred to as the "Government") a temporary right-of-entry upon the Owner's property that is specific to the Remote Video Surveillance System program (not Border Wall program related). This effort is further described in Paragraph 3 below (hereinafter referred to as the "Property") for the purposes described in Paragraph 4. This right-of-entry ("ROE") is granted upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Property subject to this right-of-entry is located in the State of Texas, County of Webb, as shown in the attached **Exhibit A (Peñitas)**.
2. The Government shall have the right to enter upon the Property for the purpose of conducting assessments and surveys, stake out, appraise, bore and take soil and/or water samples, and perform any other such work which may be necessary and incidental to the Government's assessment of the Property.
3. This ROE shall be effective for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of its approval by the Owner or Owner's designated representative.
4. This ROE includes the right of ingress and egress on other lands of the Owner not described herein, provided such ingress and egress is necessary to access the Property and is not otherwise conveniently available to the Government.
5. All tools, equipment, and other property taken upon or placed upon the Property by the Government shall remain the property of the Government.
6. Prior to entry upon the Property, Owner or Owner's designated representative will be advised of the names, time and date of entry upon the Property. Said notification must be given at least 72 hours prior to accessing the Property.
7. Request the owner affirms he or she currently holds legal title to the Property, including associated private or limited access road(s), described below.
