

SECTION 2 REQUIREMENTS

2.1 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE AGREEMENT(S) REQUIRED

- (1) Except as provided by Section 2.1(6), All all persons who generate solid waste subject to this order shall contract with the County authorized service provider for solid waste collection and disposal.
- (2) All persons who generate solid waste subject to this order under Section 1.2 shall provide proof of a valid collection agreement/contract or exception certificate under Section 2.1(6) to any County Official upon request.
- (3) All Applicants for permits, licenses, or certificates that may be incidental to the causation, creation, or generation of solid waste, shall be required to provide proof of a valid collection service agreement/contract or exception certificate under Section 2.1(6) as a condition of approval/renewal.
- (4) Solid waste collection services by the Service Provider may be suspended until all delinquent fees have been paid.
- (5) Any person who fails to either obtain a service contract or is suspended for nonpayment is subject to an enforcement action for non-compliance as further defined herein under Section 3 of this Order.
- (6) In the event that no public or private Service Provider offers trash collection services to a property subject to this order, the property owner or person who generates waste at the property may apply for an exception certificate. An exception certificate may be issued pursuant to the following conditions:
 - (a) The applicant provides written correspondence from all Service Providers that they do not provide garbage collection services to the property subject to the request for an exception;
 - (b) The applicant has submitted a waste disposal plan in compliance with state law;
 - (c) The applicant has agreed to periodic inspection of the subject property by authorized County Officials to ensure compliance with the property's approved waste disposal plan, that no hazardous conditions exist, no illegal dumping has occurred, and/or no illegal landfills have been created; and
 - (d) The applicant agrees to initiate a service contract for trash collection within 30-days of notice from the County that a Service Provider for trash collection services is available to service the subject property.
