WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER
FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DUE TO
CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Webb County resulting from the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court find that this Order is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of Webb County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for Webb County by the County Judge on March 16, 2020 shall continue until terminated by Order of the Commissioners Court.
2. This Order is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to §418.108 of the Texas Government Code and local authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 23rd day of March, 2020.
3. This Order continues the activation of the Emergency Management Plan as well as all emergency powers granted by state law.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code this declaration of a state of disaster for a public health emergency shall be given prompt general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Webb County.
