A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WEBB, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION PROGRAM SOLICITATION GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING TEN (10) USER LICENSES AND TRAINING TO AUTHOR REPORTS, ADMINISTER PROGRAMS AND UTILIZE JUSTWARE'S PROSECUTOR TECHNOLOGY; AND DESIGNATING THE COUNTY JUDGE AS THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION, ADMINISTRATION AND EXECUTION OF THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, Webb County desires to target through technology upgrades statistical areas of violent crime in order to reduce crime and improve the criminal justice system;

WHEREAS, the data and records management system now in use by the Webb County District Attorney's Office is outdated and unable to communicate with the systems in use by local, state and national law enforcement agencies;

WHEREAS, Webb County desires to promote intelligence sharing, crime reporting and communication; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of Webb County to apply for funding under the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas: Criminal Justice Division Program to reduce crime and improve the criminal justice system;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Webb County Economic Development Department shall submit an application to the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas: Criminal Justice Division Program in the amount not to exceed \$60,340.00 for the purchase of ten (10) user licenses and vendor training to author reports, administer programs and utilize Justware's Prosecutor Technology, with no County match required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Webb County, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds shall return all funds to the CJD.
