ORDER TO SUSPEND COIN-OPERATED AND GAME ROOM ENFORCEMENT SUSPENSION ORDER

Came to be heard on the 10th day of AUGUST, 2020 before the Webb County Commissioners Court a proposed order regulating Coin-Operated Machines & Game Rooms (herein after referred to as and incorporated herein as the "Order"). Said ORDER was made and entered into by the Webb County Commissioners Court during a regular session. Said order was authorized pursuant to Chapter 234 of the Texas Local Government Code (Game Rooms), and Chapter 2153 of the Texas Occupations Code (Coin-Operated Machines).

The Commissioners Court finds that the Court needs more time to review, analyze and possibly amend the regulations set out in the Order.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. The Commissioners Court after having considered and reviewed the current ORDER find that it is in the best interest of the community to temporarily suspend enforcement of the GAME ROOM ORDER for 60 calendar days.
- 2. The sixty (60) calendar days shall run from the date of this suspension order.
- 3. This ORDER shall be effective upon passage.
