In reference to an e-mail sent on your behalf by Manuel De Luna, Jr. dated November 18, 2021, requesting a Minor Boundary Modification under the Alternative Site Framework of the existing Foreign Trade Zone No. 94 located in Laredo, Texas, the Port Director, Customs and Border Protection (CBP), Port of Laredo, concurs with the request as noted in your documentation. The Minor Boundary Modification will not pose any significant enforcement challenges and will enhance utilization of Foreign Trade Zone No. 94 which is managed by the City of Laredo.
