Quality of Work

All work shall be in accordance with the respective drawings, written specifications, industry standards, trade practices, and applicable regulatory agencies. Scope of work (Camera Installtion)

- Audio Dynamics will install 280 6mp IP cameras. HikVision Model indicated on proposal.
- Hik Vision NVR Storage will provide from 30-45 days of storage. Setup of storage will be done once all cameras are connected to system.
