## ADDENDUM TO HIDTA STATE AND LOCAL TASK FORCE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 2023, between the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (hereinafter "DEA"), and the Webb and Zapata District Attorney's Office (herein "parent agency", ORI Number TX240015A. This support will include: office space, office supplies, travel funds, funds for the purchase of evidence and information, investigative equipment, training, and other support items.
