Good morning Jose. There were utility service upgrades at the sites. When we quoted, and were approved for the projects the services were 120/240 single phase. 200amp at the constable's office, and 100amp at the fire station. Sometime after the equipment was ordered, remodel began. We were not aware there would be upgrades to the electrical service, requiring changes to the equipment. The new plans called for 120/240 single-phase, 300amp at the constable's office and 200amp at the fire station. One of the generators ordered can still be used. The other is now too small, and would not be sufficient to carry the load of the building. The change is ultimately due to increase loads at both sites due to more square feet added at the constable's office, and a water tank, and pumping system at the fire station. I have attached those plans. Feel free to contact me with any questions.

Good evening Mr Lopez. Attached is updated pricing for the changes to the Quad City generator project. The difference of \$4,027.00 is due to the larger amperage ATS's with a service disconnect due to service utility increase, larger generator(50kW to 60kW) for the constable's building due to the increase of connected loads. We will be utilizing one of the generators already at the site. My supervisor has agreed to take back the equipment that will not be used that was already delivered. I completely understand. The generator for the fire station is about 3 ft wide. When Mr. Santos says the pad is for a tank, does that mean there will be no window or walls? If so we would need about 8ft from the slab. The line from the building to the septic tanks may be further than 8ft from the edge of the slab. It is my understanding the septic tanks are further back on the property? Is that correct? It is not to scale, but see below for a clearer idea of the proposed new location. Good morning Mr. Santos. I am following up on our question for generator placement. For the fire station, the red square represents the new slab that has been placed. It is over our original proposed location of the generator (black dot). We can move the generator to the left indicated by the white dot. The generator will be about 5' from the wall if there are no windows or doors in that area. If there are windows or doors within 5' we can move it to where the green dot is indicated, but there are extra costs involved since it's out of our proposed scope.

The constable's office proposed location for the generator is indicated by the white dot. There is currently a temporary access road for construction purposes, and what looks to be a phone line running along the temporary road. How far is the property line from the wall on the proposed generator location? Moving it just past the temporary road would be feasible if the property line is further out, or can the temporary road not be used already?

The generators have been released for delivery and should be arriving within the next week to two weeks. We need an answer since we planned on having the concrete pads for the generators, and run some conduits done this week or next. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.
