Habitat for Humanity addresses the housing insecurity issues in our community that have been further exacerbated by Covid-19.

Housing Support: Affordable Housing

Habitat for Humanity serves Webb County's very low and low-income qualified residents by building new homes in partnership with its participants. Energy efficient houses are designed to meet the needs of the approved applicants and include features that insure accessibility in the home as needed. Families have the opportunity and requirement to help construct their own home under the supervision of qualified construction management, and they attend homeownership classes. Habitat for Humanity of Laredo will address the housing needs of ~~two (2)~~ **three (3)** families who have disproportionately impacted by COVID-19 by providing affordable homes. Habitat for Humanity of Laredo will be acquiring two (2) properties using ARPA funds and has acquired a donated lot from the developer. Approximately \$124,000 will be utilized to construct one (1) home. Habitat will be responsible to obtain architectural plans, surveys, soil testing, all permits required and provide all management supervision. Funds will be used to purchase appropriate building materials and all related activities in the building of the home.

All procurement must adhere to Federal Procurement Laws (Uniform Guidance Title 2 CFR Part 200). As per the Sub-Recipient Monitoring Policy, Goals and Procedure guidance provided, all reporting requirements are considered "Project Activities".
