





CERTIFICATION REGARDING FEDERAL LOBBYING

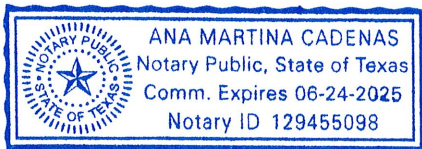

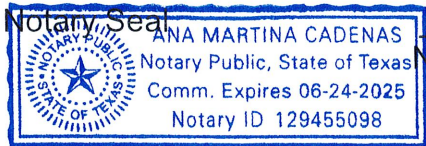
