

**RESOLUTION**  
**JUDGES & CLERKS**

**AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR ELECTION DAY PRESIDING JUDGES AND CLERKS PURSUANT TO SECTION 32.091 (a) AND 32.093 (1), TEXAS ELECTION CODE; AND ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ELECTION DAY CLERKS FOR EACH ELECTION PRECINCT PURSUANT TO SECTION 32.033, TEXAS ELECTION CODE, FOR THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014 JOINT GENERAL/SPECIAL ELECTIONS.**

**WHEREAS** Section 32.091 (a), Texas Election Code, states that a political subdivision's governing body has the authority to set election workers' compensation rate at or above the federal minimum wage, and Section 32.093 (1), Texas Election Code, defines this governing body as the County Commissioners Court for an election ordered by the governor or a county authority; and

**WHEREAS** the provisions of Section 32.033, Texas Election Code, state that the County Commissioners Court shall prescribe the maximum number of clerks that each presiding judge may appoint for their election precinct; and


**WHEREAS** the Commissioners Court of Webb County, having established and adopted an employee minimum wage, believes that election judges and clerks who are responsible for the integrity of each election polling site deserve a fair and reasonable wage equal to or above the established county minimum wage;


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Commissioners Court of Webb County that, pursuant to Section 32.091 (a) and 32.033. Texas Election Code, the compensation rate for judges and clerks is established and approved as well as the maximum number of clerks appointed for each precinct is approved as follows:


<b>Presiding Judges:</b>	<b>\$ 10.50 / Hr.</b>
<b>Election Clerks:</b>	<b>\$ 9.25 / Hr.</b>
<b>Maximum No. of Clerks:</b>	<b>Five (5):</b>

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Commissioners Court of Webb County, that said compensation rates will apply to all temporary deputy early voting judges and clerks.




