A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COUNTY ESSENTIALS PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COUNTY ESSENTIALS PROGRAM.

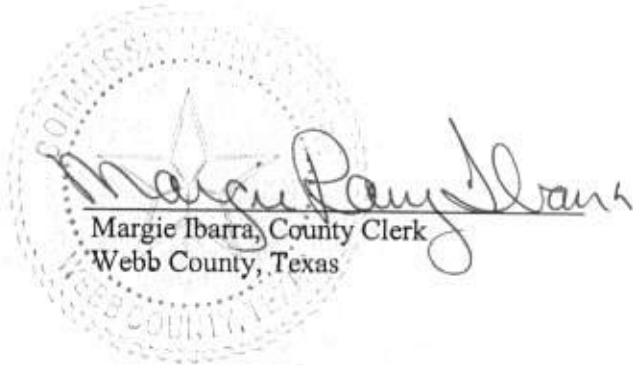
WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Webb County desires to provide increase efficiency in post-mortem services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Webb County to apply for funding under the County Essentials Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a County Essentials Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
2. That the application be for \$54,820.21 of grant funds to provide equipment and supplies to the Webb County Medical Examiner's Office.
3. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the County Essentials Program.
4. That in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to CJD.
5. That it further be stated that Webb County is not committing any cash contributions toward these activities.
