RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Webb County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Webb County to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Community Enhancement Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County of Webb with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
- 2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Enhancement Fund.
- 3. That the application be for \$350,000.00 of grant funds for a fire/EMS station to benefit the entire County.
- 4. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.
- 5. That it further be stated that Webb County is committing \$35,000 as a cash contribution toward the construction of the fire/EMS station.
