SUBCONTRACT AGREEMENT

WEBB COUNTY

AND

SERVING CHILDREN AND ADULTS IN NEED, INC.

This Subcontract is made on this 9th day of November 2015, by and between Webb County (hereinafter referred to as "Prime Contractor"), and <u>Serving Children and Adults in Need, Inc.</u> (hereinafter referred to as "Subcontractor"), a non-profit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, Webb County has been awarded <u>Contract No. 1 H79 TI026095</u> from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).

ARTICLE 1. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

 The period of performance for the Subcontract shall be from: September 30, 2015 through September 29, 2018, inclusive, unless otherwise terminated pursuant to the provisions hereof.

ARTICLE 2. SCOPE OF WORK

 The subcontractor shall provide to Prime Contractor in accordance with the Statement of Work, which is incorporated herein as **Attachment A** and made a part hereof.

ARTICLE 2. SUBCONTRACTOR CEILING

 The total value of this Subcontract issued in accordance with the terms and conditions of this subcontract shall not exceed \$208,161 per year (Year 1 is September 30, 2015 through September 29, 2016; Year 2 is September 30, 2016 through September 29, 2017; and year 3 is September 30, 2017 through September 29, 2018). Subcontractor will be incrementally funded on a cost reimbursement basis.

ARTICLE 3. WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- The Subcontractor services shall be acquired only through the issuance of the Subcontract. It shall be the responsibility of the Subcontractor to perform the work strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof and the terms and conditions of this Subcontract.
- Prime Contractor may terminate this Subcontract upon the occurrence of any of the following:
 - a. Termination by the Government of the Prime Contract upon which the Subcontractor's Statement of Work is based; or
 - b. Failure of the Subcontractor to perform work in accordance with its terms or the terms and conditions of this Subcontract and such failure is not cured within ten (10) working days after receiving a notice from Webb County specifying such failure.

3. Serving Children and Adults in Need Inc. a substance abuse treatment provider (Subcontractor) will serve at least 225 participants in the three-year project period. The population of focus is composed of female and male adults from Webb County Texas who are involved in County Court at Law II DWI Drug Court. Referred adults will receive the following services: screening, assessment, treatment planning, evidence based outpatient drug treatment, and discharge planning.

ARTICLE 4. PLACE OF PERFORMANCE

 The place of performance for work to be performed under this Subcontract shall be at the DSHS licensed outpatient office of Subcontractor located in Laredo, Webb County, Texas.

ARTICLE 5. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Subcontractor shall, at its own expense, provide and maintain during the entire performance period of the Subcontract, at least the kinds and minimum amounts of insurance specified below:
 - a. General Liability coverage of \$1,000,000 per accident.
 - b. Professional Liability coverage of \$1,000,000 per accident.
- Insurance certificates evidencing the required insurance shall be delivered to Prime Contractor prior to commencing performance. Upon expiration of such insurance before this Subcontract is complete, the Subcontractor shall automatically submit renewal certificate of insurance.

ARTICLE 6. INVOICING

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions, the Subcontractor shall invoice no more frequently than once per month. Invoices shall contain at a minimum, the following detail:
 - a. Labor hours expended;
 - All other direct costs carefully detailed to the nature, purpose and amount of the specific charge;
 - c. Total amount of invoice, current and cumulative.
- Payment of invoices shall be Net 30 days after receipt of accurate and complete invoice, which includes all required backup data and documents. The list of required documents are listed as Attachment B and made a part hereof.
