Pumphouse Summary

The Pumps were successfully installed and now operational. We have been running it with no issues.

Irrigation

We have received the first batch of 20 decoders from Toro and have schedule to have them here on the 22^{nd} of this month to start installation of the new decoders. In the meantime we have been testing the irrigation system and all the sprinkler heads we have. We have reset swing joint and level off the heads and filled the open holes that were left behind in previous irrigation work. This is allowing us a better chance to water in areas that were previously weak in growing turf. We have about 500 sprinkler heads throughout the course and we have tested all and found very few issue with the and when we do we have also been replacing and fixing to get them all working properly.

Golf Course Conditioning and Maintenance

Golf course cleanup has come a long way in the past month. Trash clean up, trimming of trees and removing of dead trees is making the course look better and better each day. All of the sand bunkers on the course have been repaired by removing grass and weeds from the inside and maintaining the edges inside and out. We are in the process of ordering sand for the bunkers and for top dressing greens and tee boxes. We have received all the new equipment and have been slowly breaking in each piece after training has been complete with each operator. Entrance and cart barn area are clean and trash free to give the customer a good first impression. Clubhouse area is kept up with weekly to stay looking clean. Currently we are targeting the only things really growing this time of year weeds. We should see a big difference in February and especially with the start of spring. We are working with Ewing Landscape and Irrigation on a chemical and fertilizer program for the remainder of the year. Driving Range has seen a lot of traffic the last couple months. We have cleaned the left side and the back adding additional targets and better turf to hit from by also making an effort to water frequently. Several ponds which were not visible because of the growth around them have now been cleaned and making the appearance much nicer. We have continued to get positive feedback from customers and are seeing new ones each day.

Golf Course Carts

We have submitted photos to the insurance adjuster and have made contact with vendor who will make the repairs on the fleet. This project should take about a week once the

parts are here. Comal Golf out of San Antonio will be doing the repair and will be here next week to get a list of necessary parts.

Again, thank you for your help. This will ensure the golf course attaining the desired conditioning we all desire.
