

ORDER CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas (the "State") ordered an election to be held throughout this state, including this County on November 7, 2017, on seven Constitutional Amendment Propositions hereinafter stated;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County (the "Court") has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the Court.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Court officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the County has complied with applicable law including the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the Court has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the State calling said election.

2. The Court officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the seven submitted Propositions by the resident, qualified electors of the County, who voted at the election:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 1

THE PROPOSITION THAT BROADENS THE SCOPE OF HOMESTEAD AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION FOR A DISABLED VETERAN OR SPOUSE.

9,473 VOTES FOR

2,579 VOTES AGAINST

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 2

THE PROPOSITION THAT PRESCRIBES CONDITIONS, FEES, REFINANCING OPTIONS, AND ELIGIBILITY FOR HOME EQUITY LOANS.

8,787 VOTES FOR

3,101 VOTES AGAINST

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 3

THE PROPOSITION THAT LIMITS THE SERVICE OF CERTAIN GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTEES AFTER EXPIRATION OF TERM.

THE PROPOSITION THAT PROVIDES HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR DECEASED (LINE OF DUTY) FIRST RESPONDER'S SURVIVING SPOUSE.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 7

2. The Court officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the submitted PROPOSITION A by the resident, qualified electors of the County, who voted at the election:

THE ISSUANCE OF \$125,000,000 WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS BONDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTING, RENOVATING, ACQUIRING, IMPROVING, AND EQUIPPING LAW ENFORCEMENT AND COUNTY JAIL FACILITIES AND NECESSARY SITES THEREFOR, AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF

9,163 VOTES AGAINST

3. The Court officially finds, determines, and declares the result of said election to be that PROPOSITION A so submitted did not receive a favorable majority vote in all respects and has failed.


