FAIR HOUSING MONTH

A PROCLAMATION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, PROCLAIMING APRIL 2018 AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH AND APRIL 9th – 13th, 2018 AS FAIR HOUSING WEEK AND CONTINUE TO DESIGNATE THE WEBB COUNTY COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING FAIR HOUSING IN WEBB COUNTY.

WHEREAS, April 2018 marks the 50th anniversary of the Passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, prohibits discrimination in housing and declares it a national policy to provide, within constitutional limits, for fair housing in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the principle of Fair Housing is not only national law and national policy, but a fundamental human concept and entitlement for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, The National Fair Housing Law, during the month of April, provides an opportunity for all Americans to recognize that complete success in the goal of equal housing opportunity can only be accomplished with the help and cooperation of all Americans.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the County Commissioners Court of Webb, do proclaim April as Fair Housing Month in the County of Webb and do hereby urge all the citizens of this locality to become aware of and support the Fair Housing law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Webb County Community Action Agency is designated as the agency responsible for monitoring Fair Housing in Webb County.

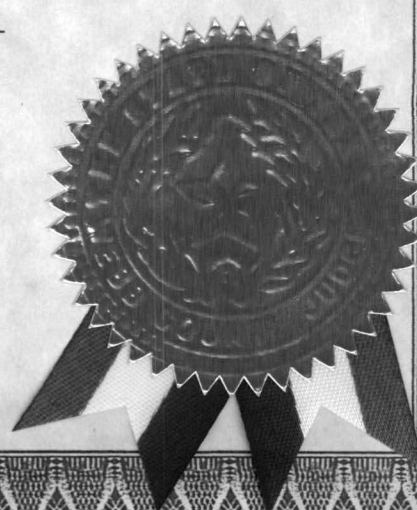


