The County of Webb understands that the City of Laredo Texas is requesting a Minor Boundary Modification application for expansion of City of Laredo's Foreign-Trade Zone (F.T.Z.) No. 94 with the Foreign Trade Zone Board/U.S. Department of Commerce as requested by Specialized Custom Services, Inc., (SCS-Inc.) Applicant & City of Laredo, Lot Number 1, Block 1, N.D.
