

Local Drought Disaster Declaration Order No. 08-26-19-12n

WHEREAS, WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS, on the 26th of August, 2019 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from severe drought conditions resulting from lack of rain over the summer in 2019 that affects crops, farming, ranching, grazing and ability to provide water to livestock and farming operations, etc.

WHEREAS, Webb County Judge Tano Tijerina, along with the members of the Webb County Commissioner's Court has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS, as follows;

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.


Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the COMMISSIONERS COURT of WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS..

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS; and.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the WEBB COUNTY emergency management plan.


That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 26th day of August, 2019.
