A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE NEED TO CROSS WORMSER ROAD AT CUATRO VIENTOS DRIVE AND GUAYMAS AVENUE AND IMPOSING NO OBJECTION THERETO

Whereas, the section of Wormser Road between Ejido Avenue and Loop 20/Cuatro Vientos Highway is within Webb County and is a County Road; and

Whereas, there is an approved Master Plan and Plat/s which identify Cuatro Vientos Drive and Guaymas Avenue as crossing Wormser Road; and

Whereas, there is a need to cross said Wormser Road precipitated by development of the Lomas del Sur Subdivision in the area; and

Whereas, the crossing of Wormser road will enhance north-south mobility within the City of Laredo and Webb County and contribute to traffic safety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEBB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT THAT:

- Article 1. It recognizes and acknowledges the need to cross Wormser Road.
- Article 2. It does not impose any objection to the crossing of Wormser Road by the extension of Cuatro Vientos Drive and Guaymas Avenue and any utility lines.
- Article 3. The costs associated with crossing Wormser Road (paving, curb and gutter, bollards and barricades as necessary) are to be borne by ALS Laredo Holdings, L.L.C, developer of the Lomas del Sur Subdivision.
- Article 4. It directs the submission of this resolution to the appropriate City of Laredo Department.
