**EMERGENCY ORDER
WEBB COUNTY JUDGE
INSTITUTING THE USE FACE COVERING (FACE
MASKS) INSIDE COUNTY BUILDINGS**

WHEREAS, by proclamation, the County Judge declared a state of disaster for Webb County;
and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared COVID-19 a National Emergency;
and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas has issued Executive Order No. GA-34 which
does not prohibit a business or other establishments from requiring employees or customers to
follow additional hygiene measures, including the wearing of a face covering; and

WHEREAS, 765 citizens in Webb County have lost their lives to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of Webb County employees and citizens is a top priority of
the County.

NOW THEREFORE, the Webb County Commissioners Court finds that COVID-19 continues
to pose an imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of citizens of Webb County;

The following regulations shall take effect immediately upon issuance, and shall remain in effect
until rescinded, amended or modified:

- Section 1: No person older than 2 years of age may enter a County building without a
face covering or face mask and continue wearing the face mask while inside
the building. A person with a disability who cannot wear a mask, or cannot
safely wear a mask, for reasons related to the disability is excepted from
mask requirement.
- Section 2: Six feet of social distancing shall be observed when inside a county
building.
- Section 3: County employees and members of the public are strongly urged to continue
hand washing
- Section 4: Webb County Building Maintenance shall continue building sanitation and

disinfection as necessary.

Section 5: Availability of face masks:


Face masks shall be provided to Webb County employees and, if available, members of the public seeking entrance to a county building.

Section 6: Severability Clause:

It is hereby declared that the phrases, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this order shall be declared to be unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining phrases, sentences, paragraphs and sections.


Section 7: This Order shall be given prompt general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Webb County.
