

I, Tano Tijerina, Webb County Judge, met with the Commissioners Court of Webb County, Texas, sitting as the canvassing board to canvass election results of the Constitutional Amendment Propositions 1 through 8 of the November 2, 2021 Special Election at a special called meeting on Monday, November 15th, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Webb County Courthouse, 1000 Houston St., 2nd Floor, Laredo, Webb County, Texas.

Having a quorum in place and having reviewed the documents submitted, we hereby certify that the figures on the pct. by pct. spreadsheet and the E.R.M. report correspond with the figures on the returns sheet. These figures include provisional ballots qualified and tallied under Section 65.057 (a) (2), Texas Election Code, and any Overseas ballots received, accepted, and tallied under Section 86.007 (d) (3), (e) & (f), Texas Election Code, if applicable.

ORDER CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas (the "State") ordered an election to be held throughout this state, including this County on November 2, 2021, on Eight Constitutional Amendment Propositions hereinafter stated;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County (the "Court") has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the Court.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. The Court officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the County has complied with applicable law including the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the Court has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the State calling said election.
- 2. The Court officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the eight submitted Propositions by the resident, qualified electors of the County, who voted at the election:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 1

"THE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING THE PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAM CHARITABLE FOUNDATIONS OF ORGANIZATIONS SANCTIONED BY THE PROFESSIONAL RODEO COWBOYS ASSOCIATION OR THE WOMEN'S PROFESSIONAL RODEO ASSOCIATION TO CONDUCT CHARITABLE RAFFLES AT RODEO VENUES."

"THE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ALLOW THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A PERSON WHO IS DISALED TO RECEIVE A LIMITATION ON THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AD VALOREM TAXES ON THE SPOUSE'S RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD IF THE SPOUSE IS 55 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF THE PERSON'S DEATH."

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITION 8

"THE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM AD VALOREM TAXATION OF ALL OR PART OF THE MARKET VALUE OF THE RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD OF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A MEMBER OF THE ARMED SERVICES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO IS KILLED OR FATALLY INJURED IN THE LINE OF DUTY."

3. The Court officially finds, determines, and declares the result of said election to be that ALL EIGHT CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSITIONS so submitted received a favorable majority vote in all respects and have passed.
