Amendment 1

To

Donation and Construction Agreement for Road Improvements on Alamo Road Webb County- EOG Resources

The original contract, approved by the Webb County Commissioners Court on May 22, 2023 and effective September 1, 2023, by and between **Webb County**, a political subdivision of the State of Texas (hereinafter called "County") and **EOG Resources**, **Inc.**, (hereinafter called "EOG") is hereby amended in the following respects:

Exhibit B, Location, Scope, Beginning and Ending Points, and Specifications of Road Improvements, Section 6. is amended by adding subsection "c":

EOG shall demolish two wooden bridge structures located at:

28°05'54.47"N 99°25'29.67" ----1,770 feet Northwest from the intersection of Raices Rd. and Alamo Rd. being

28°06'05.47"N 99°25'51.47"----3,980 feet Northwest from the intersection of Raices Rd. and Alamo Rd. being the 3rd Culvert

The demolished structures will be placed at the side of the road in a manner which will not impede or affect the flow of traffic or endanger the traveling public.

Webb County shall coordinate with EOG to pick up and dispose of the demolished structure as soon as possible.

EOG shall replace the demolished wooden structures with corrugated polyethylene drainage pipe:

- For replacement of the structure located at 28°05'54.47" N 99°25'29.67": Two (2), 30" by 40' long polyethylene drainage pipes shall be used.
- For replacement of the structure located at 28°06'05.47" N 99°25'51.47": Two (2), 24" by 40' long polyethylene drainage pipes shall be used.

Webb County shall provide EOG with the polyethylene drainage pipe as specified above for use in replacing the wooden structures.

Paragraph 2: The parties agree that the foregoing amendment shall be hereinafter considered a part of the contract referred to above and incorporated by reference therein for all purposes. The amendments shall be subject to any and all other provisions of the contract which are hereby ratified by the parties and remain in full force and effect, with the exception of the parts or provisions of the contract which have been modified by this amendment or prior amendments.

This Agreement becomes effective as of September 1, 2023 irrespective of the date signed by the last party whose signing makes the Agreement fully executed.
